Scholarship named after the Italian Cultural Institute in Seoul

Following the call for application issued on the 17th of November 2025 by Accademia Unidee - Fondazione Pistoletto Cittadellarte ONLUS, with the support of the Italian Cultural Institute in Seoul, regarding the one (1) full scholarship for participation in the annual course “Advanced Program in Public Art” for the academic year 2026/2027, the Selection Committee has completed the evaluation of applications received.

The scholarship covers full tuition and attendance fees for the entire duration of the annual course. It also includes the possibility of free accommodation in a shared double room, provided by Accademia Unidee. No monetary grant is foreseen.
